The Lake View Police Department is looking for individuals or families to provide temporary housing, food and care for stray dogs, cats, puppies and kittens . Foster volunteers will agree to care for the animals for 3 days. We need loving homes like yours to continue helping these animals .

## Foster Volunteer FAQs

### What kind of animals need foster care?

- Dogs who have been found as strays in the community
- Animals with injuries or deemed vicious will not be placed in Foster Care

### Can I become a foster volunteer if I have pets of my own?

Yes, we welcome pet owners as foster volunteers. Please keep in mind that there is always a health risk when exposing your pets to other animals, in any setting. However, the risk is minimal if your pets are vaccinated and in good health.

### How long do animals need to stay in foster care?

The typical foster stay is 3 days. If after 3 days the pets owner is not found ,the pet will be placed with Tuscaloosa Metro Animals Shelter or Birmingham Human Society.

### What expenses are involved with foster care?

Foster families provide housing, food, bedding and toys for the animals in their care. They also provide exercise, socialization and lots of love!
